



Directions to Mountaineering Ireland's office at Tollymore Mountain Centre

The Northern Ireland office of Mountaineering Ireland is located at the Hot Rock Climbing Wall, Tollymore Mountain Centre, Bryansford, Newcastle, County Down, BT33 OPT, Northern Ireland. The coordinates for Tollymore Mountain Centre should you wish to enter them in your GPS are **W 5° 57' 50" N 54° 12' 23"**

By car from the South of Ireland

Take the M1 / A1 road northbound to Newry. Follow the A1 Newry by pass around Newry for 3.75 miles. At the fourth and final roundabout, which turns left for Belfast, take the third exit following signs for Newry Town Centre. Drive towards the town centre for 1.1 miles and at the second small roundabout turn left following signs for A25 Rathfriland / Newcastle.

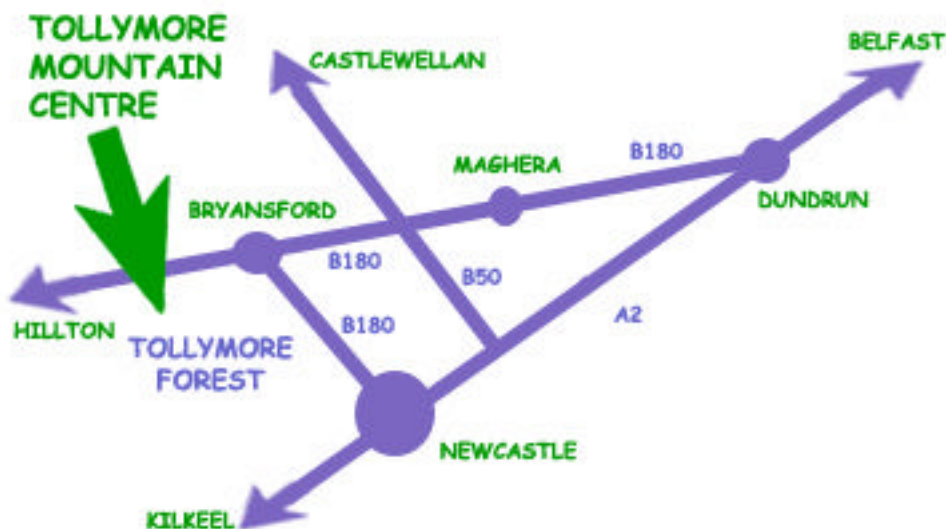
Follow this road (A25) uphill for 1.3 miles. At this junction turn right along the B8 for Mayobridge / Hilltown / Newcastle. Follow this road for 10 miles to Hilltown travelling through Mayobridge.

As you come out of Hilltown on the B27 after 1 mile turn left onto the B180 following signs for Bryansford and Newcastle. After 8 miles you will see a sign for Tollymore Mountain Centre on your right hand side opposite a small tower at the gateway. Turn right in the gate and park outside the building.

By car from the North of Ireland

Follow the A1/M1 (Northern Ireland motorway) to Exit 6 at Lisburn. Follow the A49 for 10 miles to Ballynahinch. Take the A24 to Clough, 8 miles. Follow the A2 towards Newcastle and then turn right onto the B180 for Maghera / Bryansford. Just past Bryansford you will see Tollymore Mountain Centre on your left hand side opposite the small tower. Turn left in the gate and park outside the building.
