



Irish Bouldering Championship

Ozone, Belfast 2nd April 2011

The 2011 Irish Bouldering Championship will be hosted by the Ozone wall. Categories are male/ female senior and male/ female junior. Entry costs £15 for Seniors/ £10 for Juniors / unwaged if received by 28th March or £20 on the day. The event is organised by Mountaineering Ireland and supported by Belfast City Council and Surf Mountain.

FORMAT

Qualifying (10am-2pm): Competitors will climb approximately 14 problems (unlimited attempts) . There will be no isolation during the qualifying round. The highest scoring competitors in each category will take part in the afternoon final.

Final (3pm-5pm) All finalists will be held in an isolation zone prior to climbing and will have unlimited attempts within a set time period. Registration/warm up opens at 9.00am. Registration closes at 9:30am. Climbing starts 10:00am.

ANTI-DOPING:
