

Mountaineering Ireland Youth Climbing Series 2011

Regional Rules & Regulations

In so far as possible, the Youth Climbing Series in Ireland follows the same rules as those used in the BMC. The following amendments apply only to competitions in Ireland.

BMC RULES	MOUNTAINEERING IRELAND AMMENDMENT
<p>1.2.2 Competitors will be obliged to enter the British series in the region in which they live. If a Youth Climbing Series is not organised in their nation competitors will be entitled to enter the series in a region of another nation.</p>	<p>1.2.2 Competitors may attend rounds of their choice, in either region.</p>
<p>1.2.3 Competitors may not enter events in more than one region.</p>	<p>1.2.3 Competitors may enter events in more than one region.</p>
<p>2.9.2 The aggregate points shall be recalculated after each competition and the competitors having points shall be ranked in descending order of points accumulated. The ranking shall be made available after each event of the series.</p>	<p>2.9.2 The aggregate points shall be recalculated after each competition and the competitors having points shall be ranked in descending order of points accumulated. The ranking shall be made available after the first 2 events in each region. These aggregate points have no bearing on the Irish final.</p>
<p>2.9.3 The top three climbers in each category at the end of the regional series who have competed in at least 2 rounds will qualify to enter the British Final, free of charge.</p>	<p>2.9.3 Any climber who has taken part in one or more regional rounds may enter the Irish Final. The top three climbers in each category at the Irish Final will qualify to enter the British Final, free of charge.</p>
