ENTRY FORM

The 2010 Irish Bouldering Championship will be hosted by the Ozone wall. Categories are male/ female senior and male/ female junior. Entry costs £20 for Seniors/ £15 for Juniors / unwaged if received by 1st May/ £25 on the day. The event is organised by Mountaineering Ireland and supported by Belfast City Council.

FORMAT

Competitors will climb approximately 10 qualifying problems in the morning. There will be no isolation during the qualifying round. The highest scoring competitors in each category will take part in the afternoon final. All finalists will be held in an isolation zone prior to climbing and will have unlimited attempts within a set time period. Registration/warm up opens at 9.00am. Registration closes at 9:30am. Climbing starts 10:00am.
